### Mozart (1756-1791)

Whenever people talk about classical music, the name Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart immediately comes to mind. Mozart was one of the greatest composers of all time. He was born in Salzburg, Austria, over 200 years ago.

Mozart's talent was first discovered by his father, who was a violinist and a composer. Mozart was an excellent musician, and could play the violin and piano very well. At the young age of five, Mozart also started to write music like his father.

At the age of six, Mozart's father took him and his sister on a concert tour to perform all over Europe. This was only the beginning of a life of concert tours, which made Mozart famous in Europe. The tours gave Mozart the opportunity to play and to listen to the music that was popular in Europe at that time. But, this kind of life on the road was exhausting for the young Mozart and he was often ill. Mozart made his last concert tour at the age of 22. The tour ended suddenly when his mother became ill and died. After her death, Mozart returned to Salzburg for a short time and then went to live in Vienna. At the time, Vienna was the music center of Europe. Surprisingly, this great composer found it hard to make living there. He did not have a permanent job and spent his time composing and giving private music lessons to earn money to buy food and clothes for his family. When Mozart died at the early age of 36, he was poor, sick and unhappy. Today, however, Mozart's talent is appreciated and enjoyed by music lovers everywhere.



# Trumpet



The trumpet may be known best for its use in American jazz, symphonies, and school marching bands, but it has a long history that includes several instruments. It is in the brass instrument family, along with the tuba, trombone, French horn, and euphonium.

Trumpets made are made by the player's closed lip vibrating while he blows air through the brass tubes. The player can change the notes by the pressing on their valves. Not all brass instruments are made of brass, and not all brass instruments are considered brass instruments. The saxophone, for example, is made of brass but is considered a woodwind instrument.



The trumpet is one of the few brass instruments known to feature a B♭ key. The B♭ key is used when playing notes that are not natural or when needed to be lowered an octave. In musical terms, notes used together as they change over large areas (it's sometimes confused with the flugel, which is a brass instrument that is famously used by the British Royal Air Force). The same is another instrument often confused with the trumpet.

In the early and mid 1900s, the trumpet became a central part of the United States as jazz music was developed. Two of the most famous and influential trumpeters are Miles Davis and Louis Armstrong. People will learn in their music, and musicians will notice their styles.

## Hey Kids, Meet Johannes Brahms

German Romantic Period (Composer 1830-1897)

Johannes Brahms was born in Hamburg, Germany on May 7, 1833. Johannes' father, an avid musician, gave him his first musical instruction. At the age of seven, he studied piano with Otto Friedrich Meißner. Young Brahms gave concerts in Hamburg and worked playing piano in restaurants and theaters to help support his family.



When Brahms was 20 he met famous composer Franz Liszt and Robert Schumann. Schumann was so impressed with Brahms' music that he wrote an article for a music journal that made Brahms famous. Brahms' success was also due to his hard work and his critical skills he learned by listening to his father's work and his critical skills he learned by listening to his own music. He never felt he could live up to the standard set by Ludwig van Beethoven.

Brahms was one of the few music composers who could devote his time completely to composing without having to accept other employment. In fact, he spent so much time with his composing that he sometimes neglected his appearance. Sometimes, when he forgot to brush his mustache, he would have to fold his pants up while conducting to keep them from falling down.

In 1889 Thomas Edison, an American inventor, visited Brahms in Vienna and invited him to perform for an experimental recording. Brahms played an abbreviated version of Giuseppe Verdi's Otello. The performance is one of the earliest recordings ever made by a major composer.

In later years, Brahms often participated in performances of his own compositions. In 1890, at the age of 57, he decided to give up composing. But this did not last long. He soon started composing again and his efforts in these final years produced several works that are now recognized as masterpieces.

Johannes Brahms died on April 3, 1897, a celebrated composer of the Romantic Era. His most popular works include his Double Concerto for Violin and Cello, Liebeslieder-Walzer, Academic Festival Overture and his Lullaby.
